RESOLUTION # 2020-52

AN RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO FINALIZE A NEGOTIATED DISPOSITION OF A CIVIL LEGAL MATTER WITH JOHN BROWN AND KATHY ALCORN AND APPROVING SAID AGREEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Wellston is the Plaintiff in Jackson County Court of Common Pleas Case No. 19 CIV 116; and,

WHEREAS, John Brown and Kathy Alcorn are the Defendants in that matter; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Wellston, by and through its mayor, has negotiated an agreement resolving the matter fully; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Wellston, Ohio, to enter into agreement, in accord therewith.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Wellston, County of Jackson, State of Ohio:

Section One. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute any document necessary to finalize an agreement disposing of Jackson County Court of Common Pleas Case No. 19 CIV 116, City of Wellston v. John Brown, et al.

Section Two: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Wellston, in that it is necessary to approve this additional appropriation in order that expenses can be timely paid as incurred and in accordance with the city's obligations. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in the Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three: In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, the this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four: It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and the deliberations of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
