RESOLUTION NUMBER: 2020-54

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FORMATION OF A PARTNERSHIP WITH JACKSON COUNTY TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION AND AUTHORIZING JACKSON COUNTY TO ACT AS THE LEAD APPLICANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Wellston has identified the need to repair a Bridge on Wellston Park Road (the Scenic Highway); and,

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has funds available for such projects through the Ohio Public Works Commission; and,

WHEREAS, Jackson County and the City of Wellston have agreed to form a partnership and, as such, are eligible to apply for Ohio Public Works Commission funds to help meet the bridge replacement project costs; and,

WHEREAS, the Ohio Public Works Commission is requiring that one entity of the partnership take the lead and be the Lead Applicant and official Grantee and that Jackson County has agreed to be the Lead Agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Wellston, Ohio to enter into a partnership with Jackson County to prepare the grant application through the Ohio Public Works Commission to pay the costs of the Wellston Park Road, (Scenic Highway) Bridge Replacement project.

SECTION 1. To hereby authorize Jackson County to be the Lead Applicant, and assume the role of Grantee, with the City of Wellston in the role of Partner.

SECTION 2. To hereby authorize the Mayor and any other necessary City officer, to enter into a Partnership Agreement with Jackson County.


SECTION 3. To acknowledge and pledge to comply with all conditions and assurances of the partnership, funding program, equal opportunity and other state and federal regulations as applicable.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Wellston. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in the Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

SECTION 5. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.



### COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

City of Wellston Resolution Number: 2020-54

Date: 10-15-2020

Jackson County and The City of Wellston enter into a cooperation agreement to submit an application to the Ohio Public Works Commission for the 2021 Jackson County Bridge Replacement Project.

Jackson County will provide funds equal to 100 percent of the total project cost. Such funds will come from Road and Bridge fund.

The City of Wellston will provide funds equal to 0 percent of the total project cost.

The City of Wellston authorizes Jackson County to serve as lead applicant and to sign all necessary documents.

Jackson County agrees to pay it's 100% of the cost as invoices are due.
