ORDINANCE NO. 2020-13

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING REGULAR BLANKET CERTIFICATES FOR THE YEAR 2020, SETTING EXPIRATION DATES FOR REGULAR CERTIFICATES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, the City Auditor may be authorized to issue regular blanket certificates with an expiration date no later than December 31st of the year for which said regular blanket certificates are issued in an amount not to exceed an amount set by ordinance, and;

Whereas, the legislative authority for the City of Wellston previously authorized said blanket certificates, setting an expiration date and authorizing issuance in an amount not to exceed Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00); and

Whereas, the legislative authority for the City of Wellston has determined it appropriate and desires to amend its prior authorization to authorize the Auditor to issue blanket certificates for the year 2020 to allow certification in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00),

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF WELLSTON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The Auditor for the City of Wellston is hereby authorized to issue regular blanket certificates for the year 2020 with an expiration date no later than December 31st of the year for which said regular blanket certificates are issued, being 2020, and in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00).

Section Two. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Wellston, in that it is necessary to approve this ordinance in order that current expenses can be timely paid as incurred and in accordance with the city's obligations. Therefore this Ordinance shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in the Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Four: In the event this Ordinance receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, this Ordinance shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Five: It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and the deliberations of the council and any of its committees that


resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
