ORDINANCE # 2021-01

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH THE FULL TIME MEMBERS OF THE WELLSTON FIRE DEPARTMENT FOR THE PERIOD FROM JANUARY 1, 2021 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2023 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wellston operates the Wellston Fire Department;

**WHEREAS**, the Wellston Fire Department employs full time personnel with the conditions of employment traditionally detailed in a written employment contract;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wellston believes it to be in the best interests of the City to enter into an employment contact with the full-time employees of the Wellston Fire Department;

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor has negotiated the terms of an employment contract with the full-time employees of the Wellston Fire Department for the period of time from January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2023, a copy of which is attached hereto.

**NOW THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the City of Wellston, County of Jackson, State of Ohio:

**Section 1.** The Mayor is hereby authorized to finalize the terms of and execute an employment contract with the full-time employees of the Wellston Fire Department, a copy of that agreement has been provided to Council attached as Exhibit A, and said Exhibit A is hereby approved and adopted by this body.

**Section Two:** This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Wellston, in that it is necessary to approve this additional appropriation in order that expenses can be timely paid as incurred and in accordance with the city's obligations. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in the Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

**Section Three:** In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

**Section Four:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and the deliberations of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
