

RESOLUTION 2021-28

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, OHIO APPOINTING MINDY EISNAUGLE AS CLERK OF COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Wellston desires to elect a clerk to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of its prior clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Wellston has determined that Mindy Eisnaugle meets the qualifications and has the desired skills for the position, and

WHEREAS, the Council for the City of Wellston desires to appoint Mindy Eisnaugle to the position for the 2020-2021 term at the previously adopted pay rate and involving established job duties, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCLL OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION ONE. The Council of the City of Wellston, Ohio does hereby "elect"/ appoint Mindy Eisnaugle as the Clerk of City Council for the City of Wellston pursuant to the salary and employment terms already in place for the position.

SECTION TWO. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and of any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with R.C. 121.22.

SECTION THREE. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health or safety of the City of Wellston, in that it is necessary to approve this additional appropriation in order that expenses can be timely paid as incurred and in accordance with the city's obligations. Therefore this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in the Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

SECTION FOUR. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, the this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause, and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
