A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT AND / OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM(S) AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the City of Wellston, Jackson County, Ohio is planning to make capital improvements to New York/Broadway Streets Improvements project, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Authority for the City of Wellston:

Section 1: That the Mayor of the City of Wellston is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described herein and is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and the deliberations of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
