A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 2021 OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION "TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP)" AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED

WHEREAS, the Transportation Alternatives Program provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for non-motorized transportation facilities, historic transportation preservation, and environmental mitigation and vegetation management activities, and

WHEREAS, the City of Wellston is planning to make capital improvements to City sidewalks downtown, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the Transportation Alternatives Program; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Wellston, Jackson County, Ohio:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to ODOT for funds as described above.

Section 2: The Mayor is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
