ORDINANCE 2021-69

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF 12TH STREET RUNNING EAST-WEST FROM SOUTH RHODE ISLAND AVENUE TO SOUTH NEW HAMPSHIRE AVENUE

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 723.05 the City Council has determined that there is good cause for vacating a road located, as depicted on attached "Exhibit A", and that such vacation will not be detrimental to the general interest; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 723.06 notice is not required as the legislative authority has the consent to such vacation of all the owners of the property abutting the part of the street or alley proposed to be vacated; and

WHEREAS,

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF WELLSTON, OHIO, JACKSON COUNTY, HEREBY ORDAINS THAT:

Section One. The Council of the City of Wellston hereby finds there is good cause for vacation of and said vacation is not detrimental to the general interest of the public and hereby vacates the portion of 12th Street running East-West from South Rhode Island Avenue to South New Hampshire Avenue abutting Parcel Nos. M240310032801 on the North side of the roadway and M240310019400 and M240310019500 on the South side of the roadway; and as detailed in attached Exhibit A.

Section Two. The City hereby retains a utility easement, including but not limited to: electric, storm sewer, sanitary sewer, water line, cable line and gas line.

Section Three. It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and the deliberations of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
