**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON TO AN AGREEMENT WITH DLZ, INC. TO PERFORM ENGINEERING AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Wellston has determined it to be within the City's best interest to pursue the financing and construction of a new water treatment plant, and

**WHEREAS**, the prospective project would require preliminary engineering work to be completed, and

**WHEREAS**, the City wishes to contract with DLZ Inc to perform those engineering services.,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Legislative Authority for the City of Wellston:

**Section 1:** That the Mayor of the City of Wellston is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with DLZ, Inc. to perform engineering services related to the City exploring replacement options for its water treatment plant.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30 and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City or Wellston, Ohio and as such shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval.

**Section 3:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this council and the deliberations of the council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
