RESOLUTION NO. 2022-05

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF WELLSTON TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE 2021/2022 OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION "TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP)" AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DELARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Transportation Alternatives Program provides financial assistance to political subdivisions for non-motorized transportation facilities, historic transportation preservation, and environmental mitigation and vegetation management activities, and

WHEREAS, the City of Wellston is planning to make capital improvements to Ohio Street downtown, and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the Transportation Alternatives Program,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the CITY OF WELLSTON:

SECTION 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to ODOT for funds as described above and is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

SECTION 2. This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30 and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Wellston, Ohio and as such shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval.

SECTION 3. It is hereby found and determined that all formal acts of this council concerning and relating to adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and the deliberations of this council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
