Thank you for your application in the Transportation Alternatives Program. Considerable time and effort were spent reviewing each application for its transportation need, costs, and benefits to the local community. The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) is pleased to inform you that the Ohio Avenue project has been selected for funding in the Transportation Alternative Program.

In the past, ODOT has provided 80% of the eligible costs in Federal funds through the Transportation Alternatives Program. This year, ODOT is utilizing Toll Revenue Credit (TRC) and will provide 95% of the eligible costs in Federal funds, up to a maximum of \$697,538 in Federal funds through the Transportation Alternative Program, in State Fiscal Year 2025.
