Essential Functions:

- Performs assigned lead/supervisory duties, including receiving work schedules from the Infrastructure Foreman.
- Delegating individual responsibilities and projects to crew members and contractors
- Replace and install all facets of the city's infrastructure from plumbing to concrete to pavement repairs.
- Must be able to install water lines up to 12'
- Must be able to install fire hydrants
- Must be able to tap and install service lines
- Operate as part of a small three-man team to accomplish a common goal.

- Operates heavy trucks and heavy equipment and performs normal cleaning and maintenance of equipment as required.
- Digs and braces ditches.
- Erects barricades and signs.
- Sets, raises and lowers manholes.
- Performs masonry work.
- Builds, forms, and works as concrete finisher.
- Performs grading and seeding to restore water and sewer line replacement projects.
- Keeps records pertaining to street construction, as well as signs, painting, personnel, job costs, vehicle mileage, equipment usage, etc.
- Reads location of items using hand-held GPS for GIS mapping system.
- Prepares soil and plants, cultivates flowers, grass and shrubs.
- Makes, repairs, installs, removes and paints metal street signs and other necessary signs.
- Paints buildings, railings, curbs, streets, vehicles and equipment as needed.
- Assists mechanics, carpenters, painters and other tradesmen where special skills are usually not required.
- Operates the following equipment and performs normal cleaning and maintenance on equipment as required:
 - Industrial-type tractor with front-end loader and backhoe attachment
 - Farm-type tractor with both rear and side-mounted mowing attachment
 - Salt spreader and snow plow
 - Road grader to shape beams, base courses or shape sub-grades
 - Front-end Loader
 - Street Sweeper
 - Sewer/catch cleaner, Jet truck
 - Street painting equipment

- Jack hammer
- Asphalt roller
- Plate tampers
- Fork lift
- Weed eaters
- Brush chipper
- Post puller and driver
- Paint machine
- Vacuum Truck
- Other equipment as required
- Assumes additional responsibilities and performs other related duties as required.

Position Qualifications:

- High School diploma/GED required.
- A minimum of five years' experience in operating heavy duty equipment and street construction is required.
- Must possess a valid Ohio driver's license with acceptable driving record.
 - Required to have a valid Class B Commercial Driver's License.
 - May be waived up to 1 year, permit required within 6 months.
- An excellent driving record is a requirement for employment and must be maintained.
- Must be able to lead a crew to complete assigned tasks
- Be able to install water mains and sewer mains
- Be able to install water and sewer taps
- Be able to install fire hydrants
- Be able to follow Engineering drawings and directions
- Be able to install water run-off basins and control water run-off

Preferred Qualifications:

- Ability to install water and sewer mains. This is to include taps and line connections.
- Be able to lead a crew on finishing concrete projects of all types
- Be able to install storm basins and grade water run-offs
- Five years' experience pouring, forming and finishing concrete.

Position Requirements

- Must be able to meet the attendance requirements of the position, which includes emergency call-outs.
- Skill in the operation of vehicles and heavy equipment is required as well as knowledge of the principles on which the engine operates
- Must be able to work under varying climatic conditions for extended periods of time.
- Required to be able to lift up to approximately 75 pounds to chest height.

- Mental and visual alertness and sound judgment on the part of a maintenance technician are required for safe operation of equipment.
- Must be able to operate and train others on operation of garbage truck
- Must be able to operate and train others on operation of Vacuum truck
- Must perform duties with minimum amount of supervision, must be self-motivated.
- The employee must follow the safety practices of the city and use the necessary personal protective equipment appropriate to the job assignment. Also required to ensure members of their crew follows all safety rules.

The City provides a seven-day per week and twenty-four hours per day service, and therefore, certain employees may be required to work evenings, nights, weekends, holidays, and are subject to emergency call-outs.

This position has been identified as being occupationally-at-risk for bloodborne pathogens. Safety precautions and procedures must be followed in the exercise of duties.

Any one position may not include all of the duties listed, nor do the examples cover all the duties that may be performed. It is not intended to cover all situations, or all necessary qualifications.
